NIA OPENS FIRST 24-HOUR PRESTIGE CENTRE IN ACCRA

The National Identification Authority (NIA) is pleased to announce the introduction of the **NIA Prestige Centre**, a premium service designed to provide faster, more convenient and flexible access to Ghana Card registration and related services.

The first Prestige Centre will begin operations on **Saturday, 1st August 2026**, at **Labone, Accra**.

As part of the Authority's commitment to improving service delivery and enhancing the customer experience, the Prestige Centre will operate **24 hours a day, seven days a week**, including weekends. This will enable members of the public to access NIA services at any time that is convenient for them.

The Prestige Centre is a fee-based service. All services provided at the Centre will attract the applicable approved fees. It complements the Authority's existing registration centres by offering an additional option for individuals who require greater convenience, flexibility and faster service.

The NIA wishes to assure the public that the Labone Centre is the first of several Prestige Centres planned across the country. Additional centres will be announced as they become operational.

The Authority remains committed to making identity services more accessible, efficient and secure while delivering a customer-centred experience for all eligible applicants.
